Overview



After 15 successful years in the forest industry in BC and overseas in New Zealand, Dean Sinclair started DCS Consulting Ltd. in November 2008 to provide safety consulting and safety auditing services to clients throughout BC and Alberta. Throughout much of his career he has been involved in safety management and has over 10 years of experience in safety. In 2004 he successfully completed a National Certificate of Occupational Health and Safety while working in New Zealand and in 2012 he became a Canadian Registered Safety Professional (CRSP). Future professional development includes becoming a certified Project Management Professional (PMP) and a Certified Health and Safety Consultant (CHSC).

A main focus has been as an external auditor for the WorkSafeBC Partners Program and Dean was one of the early certified external auditors for the BC Forest Safety Council (BCFSC) COR program, becoming certified in 2007. Since 2007 he has become a certified external auditor for the BC Construction Safety Alliance (2008), BC Municipal Safety Association (2010 - 1 of only 8 certified external auditors), Trucking Safety Council of BC (2011 - 1 of only 8 certified external auditors) and Enform (2013). To date, Dean has completed COR audits on over 300 large and small organizations in a variety of industries including health care, construction, road maintenance and construction, forestry, manufacturing and consulting.

Recently a focus has been on developing custom training programs for the Trucking Safety Council of BC. Courses developed to date include Safety Law, Safety Communications and Incident Investigation with additional courses currently under development.
